

Mar Jiménez

In addition to a PhD in Genetics from the Complutense University of Madrid, 1991, Mar Jiménez has extensive hands-on experience as a secondary school teacher, including as Assistant Principle and Head of Department (1993-2001). In 2001 she was appointed Secretary of the Management Team of the Teacher Centre of Coslada (Madrid), where she was also Advisor of the Scientific and Technological Field. From 2003-2008 Jiménez was the Director of Coslada Teacher Centre and in 2008 she started her career at the Ministry of Education. She has been Education Technical Adviser at the Ministry of Education for several years; since 2009 she has been Supervisor of the Department of Professional Development and Institutional Relations for the Spanish Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports. She has organized, coordinated and directed numerous courses, ENSME 117 seminars and conferences offered by the Spanish Ministry of Education. In addition, she has also been a speaker for training courses, participated in panel discussions on various national and international conferences and served as evaluator and jury for several contests and awards, i.e.: It's a book. Research Prize San Viator, European Language Label, Rosa Sensat, etc. From 2009 to 2013 she was the Spanish representative at the working group on science and mathematics education, with a particular focus on low-achieving students. For the last six years she has been the Coordinator of the Technical Commission for Teacher Education Conference. Furthermore, she is responsible for the Technical Secretariat of the Latin American Network of Technology and Education (RIATE).
